bE-Open is an online tool aimed at supporting local authorities in their efforts to improve the quality of local democracy by providing practical guidance on public ethics, accountability, transparency and citizen participation.

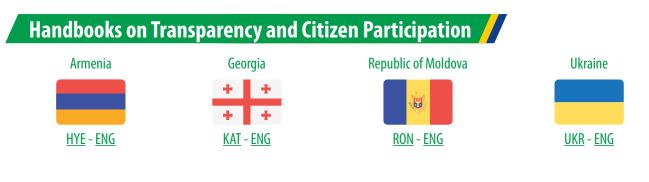
Local governments play a crucial role in building citizen trust and fostering participatory decisionmaking, especially in the absence of strong institutional frameworks that promote public ethics and accountability. Without their concerted action, corruption and malpractice can thrive, undermining the foundations of a peaceful and prosperous society. Thus, the integrity of local elected representatives and their administrations, and their ability to function in a transparent and accountable manner is all the more important to provide fair services to citizens.

How does it work?

bE-Open provides quick and easy access to relevant international standards and domestic context, legislation, case law, guidelines and good practices in <u>Armenia</u>, <u>Georgia</u>, the <u>Republic of Moldova</u>, and <u>Ukraine</u> – categorised in four themes: Public ethics and accountability, Corruption risks, Transparency and Citizen participation.

Who is it aimed at?

Local and regional governance actors in their efforts to improve the quality of local democracy in their villages, towns, cities and regions, as well as citizens interested in public ethics and open local government. **bE-Open** is available in English and in the local languages.
