### Background:

This morning will provide the opportunity for a brainstorming and exchange of views on the future of the functioning of the Congress and the impact of its work. Taking into account the Congress' position in the Council of Europe's institutional architecture, its unique role in bringing the local and regional dimension of democracy to the work of the Organisation, and its recently adopted priorities, the debate will focus on the Congress' strengths and assets, challenges and weaknesses with a view to

- developing a shared vision of the Congress' future based on the Congress' priorities,
- reflecting on its structures, working methods, and
- identifying needs for reforming and streamlining rules and procedures.

There will be a 20 min. general introduction by the President and the Secretary General on the context and the objectives pursued by the exercise. The Director will then provide the background on the Congress institutional position, procedures and resources.

After the general introduction, participants will consider two thematic blocks (1 hour each); one on the Congress structure, procedures and resources and the other on its work and activities. There will be a coffee break between the two.

Introductory interventions will set the context for each of these two blocks: the presidents of the Congress and its chambers will introduce the first block, the chairs of the committees, the second block.

The introductory interventions will be followed by an exchange with Bureau members and participants all of which are called upon to play an active role.

More specifically, the first block will focus on the Congress structure, procedure and resources and address the following issues: institutional setting (chambers, bureaux, committees), procedural setting, and resources (members, delegations and staff).

The second block will be devoted specifically to the substantial political work of the Congress as regards topicality, relevance, sustainability, and impact. Are we fulfilling our mission with regard to the Congress' mandate and stake holders? It is not intended to question the agreed priorities, but rather to focus on the modus operandi on topics and follow-up.

Based on the outcomes of this brainstorming, follow-up will be devised.
