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PROJECT INPUTS

REINFORCEMENT OF CAPACITIES AND ENSURING SUSTAINABILITY - CROSS-CUTTING OBJECTIVE:

- ***OVERALL POLICY AND LEGISLATIVE ACTIVITIES***
- ***PROFESSIONAL CAPACITIES/TRAINING FRAMEWORK***
- ***INSTITUTIONAL and OPERATIONAL CAPACITIES / EQUIPMENT = SPECIFIC CAPACITIES IN ADDRESSING ISSUES BY THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE SECTOR STAKEHOLDERS***

PROJECT INPUTS/OUTPUTS

OVERALL POLICY AND LEGISLATIVE ACTIVITIES / RESEARCH

- *Enhancement of the legislative framework in addition to the PPS, PA, including constitutional amendment: support to a number of specific VC opinions (e.g. Mandate of Security)*
- *Support to implementation and advancement of the justice sector and HR policy frameworks (evaluation of JSRS 2011-2016, inputs for developing a new one; developing development of the new National Human Rights Action Plan 2018-2022 etc.).*
- *Baseline study on the criminal subculture in prisons*

PROJECT INPUTS/OUTPUTS

PROFESSIONAL CAPACITIES/TRAINING FRAMEWORK

- *Balanced combination of international expert input focused on **developing domestic capacities** and support to subsequent **use and advancing national potential***
- *Provision/development of **training materials**: translation of the HELP methodology, literature, adjusted modules (e.g. ECtHR Compendium; PA Office/NPM on prevention of ill-treatment)*
- *Advanced **training methods**: HELP courses ‘Pre-trial investigation’, ‘Ill-treatment’, ‘Admissibility Criteria’, ‘Domestic violence’ (adaptation, support)*
- *Advancement of **NIJ capacities**, incorporation in its curricula, Resource Group; + extension and support **to the Bar/Advocates** (HELP courses)*
- *Set of ToT and subsequent cascades = **pools of trainers** (DIP, MIA, PA)*
- ***Relevant substantial scope**: focused on ill-treatment, criminal justice-related and other rights (non-discrimination) and issues (e.g. leadership and management, communication, medical treatment of inmates etc.)*

PROJECT INPUTS/OUTPUTS

- **INSTITUTIONAL and OPERATIONAL CAPACITIES / EQUIPMENT for ADDRESSING SPECIFIC ISSUES**
- **PPS, PA/NPM: best practices in terms of core functions; set-up; regulations; transparency and communications, corruption risks assessment in the PPS**
- **Equipment: DIP - photo/video cameras, surveillance devices, scanners, printers; PPS - IT**
- **Adjustment/advancement of the *institutional, procedural and legal framework* = mechanism of effective investigation of ill-treatment + capacity building**

Further Steps

- *Policy development and implementation arrangements (re-gain trust and sector support)*
- *Maintain and reinforce operational, institutional, normative, procedural, coordination capacities, mechanisms*
- *Effectively use and advance training / personnel capacity building potential and structures*
- *Maintain and expand infrastructure, introduce innovative methods and equipment*
