Common ground – Defined common interest

<u>Article 8 Environment</u>: reinforce social cohesion by fostering a sense of shared responsibility towards the places in which people live.

<u>Article 2 Definition:</u> Cultural heritage includes all aspects of the environment resulting from the **interaction** between **people** and **places** through time.

<u>Article 7 Dialogue</u>: Encourage respect for diversity of interpretations


Faro Applications:




