HOW TO INITIATE REALISTIC CHANGE?

Analyse the national legal framework and detention policy against applicable human rights standards

Evaluate the scale, nature and vulnerabilities of migration flows Study relevant international good practice

Determine the availability and effectiveness of existing alternatives?

- ...to what extent are current alternatives used in practice?
- ...how effective are current alternatives?
- ...why are current alternatives more or less effective?
- ...can existing services be adapted to strengthen the effectiveness of alternatives?

Calculate costs of developing different forms of alternatives for different cohorts, including vulnerable persons and children
