Croatia joins Eurimages

STRASBOURG, 20.11.2002 - As from 1st January 2003, Croatia will become the 28th country to join Eurimages, the support fund for the co-production, distribution and exhibition of European cinematographic works.

Consequently, projects involving a Croatian co-producer can be presented for the forthcoming deadline for applications on 10 January 2003. Croatia will also be able to benefit from the Distribution and Cinema support schemes.
