Prof. Dr. Ton Liefaard is Professor of Children's Rights and holds the UNICEF Chair in Children's Rights at Leiden Law School, Leiden University, the Netherlands. He teaches children's rights and child law from an international and comparative perspective and has published widely on the meaning of the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child and related international and regional instruments for the position of children. Prof. Liefaard is the Programme Director of the <u>Master of Laws: Advanced Studies in International Children's Rights</u> at Leiden University and coordinates the <u>Leiden Summer School on International Children's Rights</u>. He has received the award for <u>best lecturer of Leiden Law School</u> in 2015.

He regularly works as a consultant for international organizations, including agencies of the United Nations, the Council of Europe and the European Union, on issues related to children's rights, child friendly justice, child protection, juvenile justice, alternative care and violence against children.
