Santiago Oñate Laborde, Mexican diplomat, jurist and politician, currently Permanent Observer of Mexico to the Council of Europe.

He has also served his country as Permanent Representative to the Organisation of American States (1991-1992); Ambassador to the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland (1997-2001); Ambassador to The Kingdom of The Netherlands (2001-2003) and as Agent before the International Court of Justice in the case *Avena et autres ressortissants Mexicains* (Mexique c. Etats-Unis d'Amérique).

Deeply involved in the OPCW and in the development of the Chemical Weapons Convention as Permanent Representative of Mexico from 2001 to 2003, as Legal Adviser from 2004 to 2012, and as Special Adviser to the Director-General in the preparation of the 3th Review Conference (2013).

He has written articles and books on Human Rights, Civil Procedure, Sociology of Justice, Environmental Protection and Disarmament.
