Radek Policar holds the JUDr. degree from the School of Law at the Masaryk University. He also completed the advanced state exams in the field of labour law at the same institution. Furthermore he studied at the Institute for Postgraduate Education in Health Services in the field of health law. Until this day he regularly attends congresses, conferences and seminars on health law as speaker. Radek Policar published two books and numerous articles on law and management in health services.

In the years 2000 – 2004, Radek Policar worked at the Public Procurement Department and later as the deputy director of Legal Section of the University Hospital Brno. Later he served as the head of Legal Department and as the deputy director for Legal Services and HR at the Masaryk Memorial Cancer Institute in Brno. Besides he was the head of the Institute of Social Medicine and Public Health at the Masaryk University in the years 2013 – 2014.

Since the year 2015, Radek Policar serves as the Deputy Minister for Legislation and Legal Affairs at the Ministry of Health of the Czech Republic.
