Ucha Vakhania, MD is the chairman of Taoba – CSO working in the field of elderly, and the executive director of Coalition Homecare in Georgia – the union of homecare provider institutions. He graduated from Tbilisi State University (Georgia). He had a medical practice in emergency service and hospital, worked as a head doctor for a private medical institution, and later, as a general director. From the 2000s he has been working in a civic sector and directed innovative projects which contributed in Georgia to the development of new services such as homecare, nursing home, elderly day care center, assisted living, palliative care, etc. Since recently, he has been directing the Eastern Partnership countries regional project on advocacy for elderly rights.
