MEETING REPORT

2nd meeting

6-8 March 2017

<u>Item 1:</u> Opening of the meeting, adoption of the agenda and order of business, and election of a vice-President

1. The drafting Group on the Recommendation CM/Rec(2008)2 (DH-SYS-REC) held its 2^{nd} meeting in Strasbourg, from 6 to 8 March 2017, with Ms. Emanuela TOMOVA (Bulgaria) in the chair. The list of participants appears in <u>Appendix I</u>. The agenda, as it was adopted, appears in <u>Appendix II</u>.

Item 2: Work on the Recommendation CM/Rec(2008)2

2. The Group proceeded to the examination of the preliminary draft Guide to good practice on the implementation of Recommendation CM/Rec(2008)2. It endorsed the general structure of the Guide, in conformity with the guidance given by the DH-SYSC and the CDDH and following the presentation of the Guide to good practice in respect of domestic remedies.¹

3. In the light of the proposals put forward during the meeting, a revised text will be transmitted to the Committee of Experts on the system of the Convention (DH-SYSC) in view of its 3^{rd} meeting (10-12 May 2017) (see also item 3). The Secretariat will ensure a homogeneous presentation of all parts of the draft Guide. The Secretariat is instructed to redraft relevant parts of the Guide, following changes approved or proposals made by the Group on the specific structure of certain parts. It will also ensure that when references to the same type of information are useful in different parts, unnecessary duplication will be avoided. Finally, the Group instructed the Secretariat to enrich the stocktaking as well as the part regarding means to prevent and remedy significant persistent problems in the execution process² in light of the discussions at the present meeting.

4. The Secretariat indicated that it will do its best to include in the revised text, when appropriate, relevant information contained in the national reports that have been received on the measures taken to implement the relevant parts of the Brussels Declaration. Furthermore, it noted that it would include relevant references to the proceeding of the International Conference on "Enhancing National Mechanisms for Effective Implementation of the European Convention on Human Rights" (Saint Petersburg, 22-23 October 2015). The Group agreed with these proposals.

<u>Item 3:</u> Organisation of future work

- 5. As regards the organisation of future work, the Group decided the following:
 - in view of the 3rd DH-SYSC meeting (10-12 May 2017), the Secretariat is instructed to prepare a revised version of the draft Guide based on:
 - Comments formulated at the present meeting;
 - New contributions of experts (particularly on the authority of the co-ordinator and the corresponding challenges, the action of the co-ordinator regarding individual measures, means to prevent and remedy significant persistent problems in the execution process, as well as on additional elements for the stocktaking), who are

invited to send them to the Secretariat (<u>DGI-CDDH-Reform@coe.int</u>) by <u>31 March</u> 2017;

- The revised draft Guide will be sent to the experts by <u>24 April 2017</u>;
- Experts will be invited to comment on this draft by <u>3 May 2017</u>, so that the comments can be transmitted in due course before the 3rd DH-SYSC meeting.
