Mr Ola Laurell is a Swedish national. He has a Master of Law from the University of Lund.

Mr Laurell was a prosecutor for 34 years, both in national and international duty. In 1998 he was appointed chief prosecutor and manager for a public prosecution office. From 2003-2007 he worked as chief prosecutor in the International Prosecutions Offices of Uppsala and Stockholm and was responsible for operational investigations concerning organized crime and trafficking in human beings.

In 2007 he was appointed National Member for Sweden at Eurojust and head of the Swedish office in the organisation. During his time at Eurojust, he was the Contact Point for Child Protection (2007-2012) and chair of the Trafficking and Related Crimes Team (2010-2012). He initiated a Eurojust strategic project with the aim, in particular, to identify the problems in judicial co-operation concerning cases of trafficking in human beings in the EU.

From 2012-2014 he worked in the Office of the Prosecutor General of Sweden, mainly on international judicial co-operation.

Mr Laurell is at present an independent legal consultant, specialised in international judicial co-operation and trafficking in human beings.
