■ A Project Management team has been set up to manage this project, it comprises:

- ▶ the Bureau of the Standing Committee of the European Convention on Spectator Violence;
- ▶ the European Think Tank Group of Football Safety and Security Experts;
- ▶ governmental institutions, supporter and sports organisations from Croatia, Romania and the Slovak Republic;
