The Conference is invited to:

- consider that:
 - the CDPATEP adopted, at its 2nd Meeting (Strasbourg, 12-13 May 2009), the “*Guiding Principles of the Information System of the European Landscape Convention*” which should be established by a group of specialists with the task of proposing the machinery to be developed for the European Landscape Convention in parallel to what is already being applied to the cultural heritage conventions;
 - the Committee of Ministers of the Council of Europe took note of the abridged report of the CDPATEP including this decision, on 23 September 2009 [CM/Del/Dec(2009)1066];
