Decisions

The Deputies

- 1. welcoming the proposals for immediate action contained in document SG/Inf(2015)4, invited the Secretary General to refine these proposals in the light of the debate and agreed to resume consideration of these at their 1219th meeting (11-12 February 2015);
- 2. called on those member States which have not yet done so to sign and/or ratify the Council of Europe Convention on the Prevention of Terrorism (CETS No. 196);
- 3. invited the Committee of Experts on Terrorism (CODEXTER) to accelerate its work and, within the framework of its current terms of reference, to review and update Recommendation Rec(2005)7 of the Committee of Ministers to member States concerning identity and travel documents and the fight against terrorism, in order to take into account the new phenomenon of foreign terrorist fighters;
- 4. adopted the terms of reference of the Committee on Foreign Terrorist Fighters and Related Issues (COD-CTE), as they appear in document CM(2015)19 final, with a view to the possible adoption of the draft Additional Protocol to the Council of Europe Convention on the Prevention of Terrorism at the next Ministerial Session;
- 5. invited the European Committee on Crime Problems (CDPC) to accelerate its work concerning the preparation of guidelines on how to prevent radicalisation in prisons;
- 6. agreed that the next Ministerial Session should give due prominence to the question of the fight against extremism and radicalisation leading to terrorism;
- 7. invited the Secretary General to prepare, for consideration by the Deputies in due course, a draft Declaration and draft Action Plan on the aforementioned theme with a view to their adoption at the Ministerial Session.
