SPACE data are collected and rigorously verified before publication in order to be as accurate and thorough as possible and in order to allow for valid studies and scientific comparisons across Europe of trends in penal policies and practices over long periods of time.

The current country factsheets template contains more simplified information country by country and aims at collecting the requested information sent to the Council of Europe Secretariat by the prison administrations of its member states. The same is not subjected to rigorous verifications and is based instead on the mutual trust and desire by the prison administrations to share latest data and information in a more operative way which may help to orientate the authorities when taking decisions regarding extraditions, international prisoners' transfers or other.
