National Plan 2015-2016

- Based on findings 2013-2015
- Involvement of Provincial and Regional Wildlife management Units
- Communication with stakeholders
- Review in June 2015
- Decision on continuation in July 2015



I. Actions concerning of ruddy duck in the wild

Action 1: Remove legal barriers that may hinder the control of ruddy ducks

Result 1: 8 Provinces have made that decision, 4 provinces haven't



I. Actions concerning ruddy duck in the wild

Action 2: Monitor the status and distribution of ruddy duck in the wild

Result 2:

Peak wintering numbers	33	81	76	57	67	62

I. Actions concerning ruddy duck in the wild

Action 3: Eliminate ruddy ducks in the wild following the national target

Result 3:

Year	Male	Female	Chicks	Total
2013/2014 1 april-30 march	-	-	-	-
2014/2015 1 april-30 march	1	1	5	7
2015/2016 1 april-30 march	2	1	1	4
2016/2017 1 april-25 jan	1	2	-	3



I. Actions concerning ruddy ducks in the wild

Action 4: Establish, as necessary, national working groups to guide the implementation of this eradication strategy and appoint a national focal point for international coordination.

Result 4: overall coordination by NVWA. Elimination by external parties



II. Actions concerning ruddy duck in captivity

Action 5: Prohibit the release of ruddy ducks from captivity

Result 5: Prohibited in Flora and Fauna law

Action 6: Prohibit trade in ruddy ducks by 2013

Result 6: Forbidden to trade and release species, Regulation and EU list



II. Actions concerning ruddy duck in captivity

Action 7: Monitor the status of ruddy ducks in captivity

Result 7: Unknown (best guess between 200 and 500 birds)

Action 8: Encourage the sterilisation and/or elimination of ruddy ducks in captivity

Result 8: Part of the implementation of EU IAS regulation



III. Actions concerning public awareness, reporting and international coordination

Action 9: Implement public awareness activities on the need to control ruddy ducks

Result 9: Awareness Regulation IAS stakeholders

Action 10: Report annually to the Bern Convention on national action and collaborate with other states, the Bern Convention, AEWA and other appropriate bodies in the implementation of this eradication plan and the Action plan for the conservation of the white-headed duck

Result 10: AEWA/WWT informed Sept 2016



National Plan 2016-2017

Improvements:

- * Authorisations actions Special Areas of Conservation
- * Cooperation with site management
- * Reinforcement & communication with provinces and with regard to Priorities on eradication of ruddy ducks
- * Transfer of responsibility control/elimination of IAS to provinces (New legislation for nature since 2017)




