



• Councilors: 2.382 43% women




#### Basque municipalities in figures



# THE PUBLIC SERVICES MANAGEMENT MODEL IN BASQUE MUNICIPALITIES

### A complex institucional framework

3 levels 1 - Basic State legislation

of regulation: 2- Basque parliament

3- Historic territories (provinces)

The intraterritorial regulation (within each Historic Territory or province) of intermunicipal management formulas ("mancomunidades" of municipalities, consortiums...) is the competence of the "foral" government bodies in each Historic Territory.

\*This is an exclusive <u>idiosyncrasy of the Basque</u> <u>Country</u> with respect to the rest of the State.



# THE PUBLIC SERVICES MANAGEMENT MODEL IN BASQUE MUNICIPALITIES

## Law 2/2016 of 7 April on Local Basque Institutions

#### **PRINCIPLES:**





- A system of own competences (local autonomy), based on the principles of subsidiarity and proximity, that must be complemented by a powerful management system of local public services.
- Basque legislation opts for "shared management"



#### THE PUBLIC SERVICES MANAGEMENT MODEL IN **BASQUE MUNICIPALITIES**

### Law on Local Basque Institutions (7 April 2016)

#### **KEY ARTICLES:**

- Art. 1.1. Purpose of the Law: local self-government pursuant to the principles laid down in the European Charter of Local Self-Government.
- Art. 2. Double regulation: typology of local bodies & provision of local services.



Rule of 'priority': it must be the municipality that provides the services stemming from its own competences.

 Art.9. Self-organisational power Shared management: "the right to draw up associative formulas to carry out public works and provide local public services".



# THE PUBLIC SERVICES MANAGEMENT MODEL IN BASQUE MUNICIPALITIES

### Law on Local Basque Institutions (7 April 2016)

#### **CONCLUSIONS:**

- principle of "priority provision" of public services by local bodies
- if local services cannot be managed by the municipalities concerned,
   "shared management" of the services will be preferable.
- 3. The formula of integrated management of local municipal services by the "Diputaciones Forales", therefore, must be considered an exceptional, residual solution.

<sup>\*</sup>the Law **omits a "shared" management** formula (municipalities+ "Diputaciones Forales").



### Several forms & experiences of IMC

### Mancomunidades (38)

voluntary association of municipalities to manage local services

### Consortiums (22)

Municipalities with other administrations (Basque & regional governments)

12.5 % of total expenditures of local public sector

87.5 % is managed by the municipalities.



### Consorcio de Aguas Bilbao-Bizkaia


primary water supply network and clean-up operations





- Publicly-owned utility company founded in 1967, to guarantee water supplies to the area known then as Greater Bilbao.
- This supra-municipal district comprised 80 municipalities,

and it serves over one million people: 90% of the population of Bizkaia and 48% of Basque Country.





# Consorcio de Aguas Bilbao-Bizkaia



Executive body: 80 municipalities,

Funders: Basque government and 'Diputación Foral' Bizkaia

Contributors: users (citizens) and EU



## Consorcio de Aguas Bilbao-Bizkaia

The water Consortium distributes is 2,000 times cheaper than bottled water.



- 1 bottle of water 1€
- = 1.600 liters of tap water




### 'MANCOMUNIDAD' of URIBE KOSTA (Bizkaia)

### Now includes a total of 7 municipalities of Bizkaia

• Social services, gender equality, Euskera (basque language), refuse collection, environment, employment







# MUNICIPAL DOG POUND (shared service in 'Mancomunidad' of Debabarrena)

Now includes a total of **7 municipalities of Gipuzkoa.** The dog pound facility is in the municipality of Eibar.

Collection of abandoned pets (dogs and cats).

The responsible veterinarian, serves the animals collected with a trainer entitled.



At this time the cost of this joint service amounts to **33,000 euros.**
