Background information:

As part of Council of Europe's efforts aimed at strengthening capacities of anti-money laundering and countering the financing of terrorism (AML/CFT), this international conference represents a significant inter-regional initiative related to four programmes in two regions: South East Europe (SEE) and Eastern Partnership (EaP). The Conference will be addressing issues of concerning the misuse of legal entities and persons and arrangements through beneficial ownership, while providing a road map compliance with for international standard' and the required transparency of information on beneficial ownership.

This Conference takes place in the framework of the Council of Europe's Programme on Countering Threats to the Rule of Law and three joint European Union/Council of Europe programmes¹, which are focussed on: a) support to strengthening of legislative and regulatory frameworks; b) build institutional capacities; and c) facilitate enhanced interagency and international cooperation.

Through this initiative the Council of Europe aims at strengthening capacities to fight economic crime by addressing specific shortcomings related to the transparency of beneficial ownership (as identified by GRECO and MONEYVAL), and by bringing local practices in line with relevant European standards.

While emphasising the need to strengthen the implementation of the international standards regarding the Transparency of Beneficial Ownership this International Conference aims at developing a common understanding of standards and comparative practices related to transparency of beneficial ownership among practitioners and policy makers in the two regions and to help map-out future steps such as due diligence and registry policy solutions.

Expected results:

- 1. Increase awareness of among senior policy makers on international and European standards regarding transparency of beneficial ownership;
- 2. Share practices, challenges and practical information when introducing compliance and registries as well as international cooperation on these matters; and
- 3. Map out next steps for developing and implementing transparency of beneficial ownership solutions in South-East Europe and Eastern Partnership regions.
