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Eurimages supports 11 European co-productions

STRASBOURG, 07.07.2000 -- At its 67th meeting held on 3.07.2000 - 5.07.2000 in Budapest, the COUNCIL OF EUROPE Eurimages Fund Board of Management agreed to support 11 feature films for a total amount of 3,753,000 Euros.

Since 1 January 2000, Eurimages awards assistance under two schemes. All projects presented must conform to the cultural objectives of the Fund. Under the first scheme, assistance is awarded mainly on the basis of the project's circulation potential, whereas the second scheme provides assistance primarily on the basis of artistic value.
