Eurimages supports 27 co-productions

Strasbourg, 26.06.2017 - At its 147th meeting held from 19 to 23 June 2017 in Bratislava, the Board of Management of the Council of Europe's Eurimages Fund agreed to **support 25 fiction, 1 documentary and 1 animation film projects** for a total amount of €7,104,430.

The share of eligible projects with female directors analysed at the 147th meeting of the Eurimages Board of Management Board was 27% and the share of those which received support was 39% overall as a percentage of total projects, representing €2,649,135 (a 31% financial share).

In the framework of the distribution support programme (support for marketing and publicity costs), the Board has decided to pre-select 24 distributors for a total amount of €777 252.

In the framework of the **theatres support programme**, for the 2016 programming, **57** theatres were supported for an amount of **€541 716**.

The Board decided to integrate into the Eurimages network, with retroactive effect from 1 January 2017, the following 8 theatres:

- Cinemont, Delémont (Cinemont SA), Switzerland
- Rex, Bienne (Cinevital SA), Switzerland
- Luxor Seiberian Star, Novosibirsk (Aurora-N), Russia
- Luxor, Kursk (Cinemanagement), Russia

- Luxor Center, Moscow (Aurora IDC), Russia
- Luxor Continent, Saint Petersburg (KinoProm), Russia
- Moscow Cinema, Yerevan (Moscow Cinema), Armenia

To this day, the Eurimages/Europa Cinemas network counts 66 theatres.

The Board of Management has set the following meeting dates for 2018. The deadlines of the call for projects will be the following:

- 18 January 2018
- 12 Aprill 2018
- 23 August 2018
- 23 October 2018

EURIMAGES is a support fund for cinema co-production, theatrical distribution and exhibition established by the Council of Europe in 1988 (Eurimages@coe.int – http://www.coe.int/Eurimages).

Since it was set up in 1988, EURIMAGES has supported 1862 European co-productions for a total amount of approximately €553 million.
