In the framework of the **Distribution Support Programme**, (Support for marketing and publicity costs), the Board has pre-selected 22 distributors for a total support of €770 056.

For the 2015 programming, **72** theatres were supported for an amount of **€828 202**.

The Board decided to integrate into the Eurimages network, with retroactive effect from 1 January 2016, the following 5 theatres:

- Cinema Club Neft, Yaroslavl (Cinema Club Neft), Russia
- Angleterre Cinema Lounge, Saint Petersbourg (Foundation "Kino&Teatr"), Russia
- Cinélux, Geneva (Association Cinélux), Switzerland
- Cinemarine Palm City, Mersin (Aktif Sport LTD STI Cinemarine Sinemalari), Turkey
- Cinemarine Orion, Tekirdag (Aktif Sport LTD STI Cinemarine Sinemalari), Turkey

To this day, the Eurimages/Europa Cinemas network counts 58 theatres.

The Board of Management has set the following meeting dates for 2017. The deadlines of the call for projects will be the following:

- 12 January 2017
- 20 April 2017
- 24 August 2017
- 24 October 2017

EURIMAGES is a support fund for cinema co-production, theatrical distribution and exhibition established by the Council of Europe in 1988 (Eurimages@coe.int -http://www.coe.int/Eurimages).

Since it was set up in 1988, EURIMAGES has supported 1771 European co-productions for a total amount of approximately 530 million euros.
