



APPLICATIONS FOR CO-PRODUCTION SUPPORT IN 2020: NEW DECLARATION FOR PRODUCERS

In October 2019, the Board of Management of Eurimages decided to make several changes to the current support regulations.

These changes include a new declaration to be made by the owners and/or managers of companies when applying for the Fund's support.

By making this declaration, company representatives confirm that neither they nor the companies they represent are in a situation that would exclude them from applying for the Fund's support. The specific situations involved are listed in the declaration and are called 'exclusion criteria'.

For the Eurimages co-production support programme, this means that <u>all producers</u> involved in an application will have to sign a declaration on the exclusion criteria (Chapter 1.5. of the Regulations on Co-Production Support).

A special web-based platform has been put in place to allow these declarations to be submitted easily.

Access to this declaration platform is through the project application system. Delegate producers who insert a new project into the project application platform will be directed from the project application to the declaration platform. They will also be asked to send a message via the project application system to their co-producers.

In this message, co-producers will find a link which will direct them to the declaration platform.

Declarations should be made for projects to be submitted at the 22 January 2020 deadline and for all subsequent deadlines. Please note that from the 25 August 2020 deadline onwards, absence of these declarations will prevent the submission of projects.

A users' guide for submitting the declaration is available on the welcome page of the declaration platform.

Delegate producers currently working on applications in the project application platform will also be informed by email.
