EU Action Plan for nature, people and the economy

- Updating the “Key concepts document on the period of reproduction and prenuptial migration of huntiable bird Species in the EU”;
- Supporting stakeholder platforms to address conflicts between people and protected species (on large carnivores, cormorants, and geese);
- Promoting better stakeholder involvement (including hunters and landowners) in the Natura 2000 Network;
- Developing further single and multi-species action plans for a range of bird species, including huntiable birds;
- Evaluating of the impact of the Common Agricultural Policy (CAP) on biodiversity;
- Strengthening links between natural and cultural heritage.

Council conclusions on the EU Action Plan for nature

6. Without jeopardising the conservation objectives and requirements set within the Nature Directives, RECOGNISES that the **flexibility** of implementation approaches that take into account specific national circumstances contributes to the reduction and progressive elimination of unnecessary conflicts and problems between nature protection and socioeconomic activities, as well as to addressing the practical challenges resulting from the application of the annexes to the Directives;





Fitness Check/EU Action Plan

- Identified important gaps in the effectiveness and efficiency of the implementation of the Nature Directives strengthening enforcement and allocating additional resources;
- *HIGHLIGHTS the importance of further stakeholder engagement at national, regional and local level, given the strong territorial dimension of the Nature Directives (Council Conclusions, 19 June 2017);*
- *UNDERSCORES the need to build and maintain political ownership for the implementation of the Nature Directives and to strengthen compliance...*

**Convention on the conservation of European wildlife and natural habitats -
Recommendation No. 155 (2011) on the Illegal Killing, Trapping and Trade of
Wild Birds**

Develop and support national communication strategies, promoting dialogue between all relevant interest groups, and noting cultural sensitivities. These strategies should be aimed to the conservation of bird population and based on the following principles:

- (i.) this is about illegal killing of birds, not legal hunting;**
- (ii.) zero tolerance of illegal killing of wild birds;**
- (iii.) recognition of legal hunting and sustainable use.**

CONVENTION ON THE CONSERVATION

In particular the principles;

- No. 2 - Ensure that regulations are **understandable and respected**;
- No. 3 - Ensure that harvest is ecologically sustainable;
- No. 8 - **Empower local stakeholders** and hold them accountable;
- No. 11 - **Encourage cooperation** between all stakeholders




Partly targeted at hunting tourism to ensure it stays within the boundaries of legality/wise use.

Medio Ambiente aprobará un protocolo de colaboración entre sus agentes y los guardas de coto de caza


