# STRENGTHENING DEMOCRACY AND LOCAL GOVERNANCE IN THE EASTERN PARTNERSHIP COUNTRIES: SHARING THE VISION

Thematic programme "Strengthening institutional frameworks for local governance" is being implemented by the Council of Europe Centre of Expertise for Local Government Reform, Directorate General of Democracy and the Congress of Local and Regional Authorities.

Funded by the European Union and the Council of Europe, this thematic programme is implemented by the Council of Europe through the Programmatic Co-operation Framework (PCF) for 2015-2017 for **Armenia**, **Azerbaijan**, **Georgia**, **Moldova**, **Ukraine and Belarus**. The total **budget** of the programme is € 2,570,000.

### **SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES**

- to support the on-going process of reform of local government in participating countries;
- to promote ethical behaviour by locally elected representatives of the region;
- to support the improvement of financial and human resources management of local administrations based on European standards and benchmarking processes.

#### **EXPECTED RESULTS**

- to improve the consistency of the legislative framework, streamlining new by-laws in at least three beneficiary countries and to develop targeted recommendations;
- to foster a more efficient, transparent and ethical governance at the local level in at least three beneficiary countries;
- to develop and adapt the European standard local finance benchmarking tool to the specific countries so as to improve legislation and local regulations.

#### **METHODOLOGY**

- bilateral work as well as multilateral exchange of experience and cross-fertilisation;
- special emphasis on common issues and comprehensive approach;
- flexible forum for stakeholders to discuss European standards of local governance;
- shared use of key findings and applicable European standards;
- emphasis on expertise, adaptation of approaches to national situations, bilateral assistance;
- adaptation of tools and methods to each country.

#### **MAIN ACTIVITIES**

- regional studies on the role and responsibilities of mayors and councillors, on inter-municipal cooperation and local finance benchmarking;
- conferences, workshops, bilateral round tables, as well as training sessions;

#### **PROJECT BENEFICIARIES**

Local and regional authorities and their respective associations, ministries responsible for local self-government, NGOs and citizens.

- peer-to-peer exchanges and study visits;
- awareness raising and visibility actions;
- country-specific studies and publications;
- development of recommendations for reform and legal expertise.
