Working group: Lifelong learning

Theme(s) discussed:

Adult and vulnerable people education (including women, minorities and migrants); right to education, integration, inclusion, dignity, citizenship; adaptation to moving political and economical worlds; Importance of adult education for youth education.

Aims:

In societies that are constantly changing and facing major challenges, everyone must be given the tools necessary for empowerment. This working group will reflect on the right to lifelong learning as an adult, on the involvement of economic and social organisations in adult training, as well as the close links between dignity, citizenship and employment. It will also collect good practices from INGO members to bring their expertise to the bodies of the Council of Europe working on education, social rights and citizenship.
