## Olympic Charter

- Fundamental principles of Olympism, item 6.:
„The enjoyment of the rights and freedoms set forth in this Olympic Charter shall be secured without discrimination of any kind, such as race, colour, sex, sexual orientation, language, religion, political or other opinion, national or social origin, property, birth, or other status".
- Rule 2, item 7: „to encourage and suport the promotion of women in sport at all levels and in all structures with a view to implementing the principle of equality of men and women".


## Gender Equality in Sport Commission of the Croatian Olympic Committee

- 1996 the Croatian Olympic Committee creates the Women in Sport Commission
- 2016 the Commission's name is changed into the Gender Equality in Sport Commission
- 2007 Women in Sport Commission creates the Female Coordinators in Sport Network, now Network of Gender Equality in Sport Coordinators

## National Policy for Gender Equality

## 2011-2015

- Better gender equality representation in decision-making and professional positions in sport
- Promotion of the existing legal framework and monitoring statistical data
- Providing equal access to sports infrastructure
- Availability of vocational training, in-service training and employment in sport
- Making sport safe for women and girls from all forms of violence, including sexual abuse


## International Olympic Committee recommendations

- By the end of 2000, at least $10 \%$ of women should be represented in decision-making positions,
- by the end of 2005 at least $20 \%$ of women should be represented in decision-making positions,
- by 2020 the recommended representation is $30 \%$ of women in decision-making positions in sport
- In 2010, the IOC took decision that every new sport considered to be included in the Olympic programme must have disciplines both for men and women.
