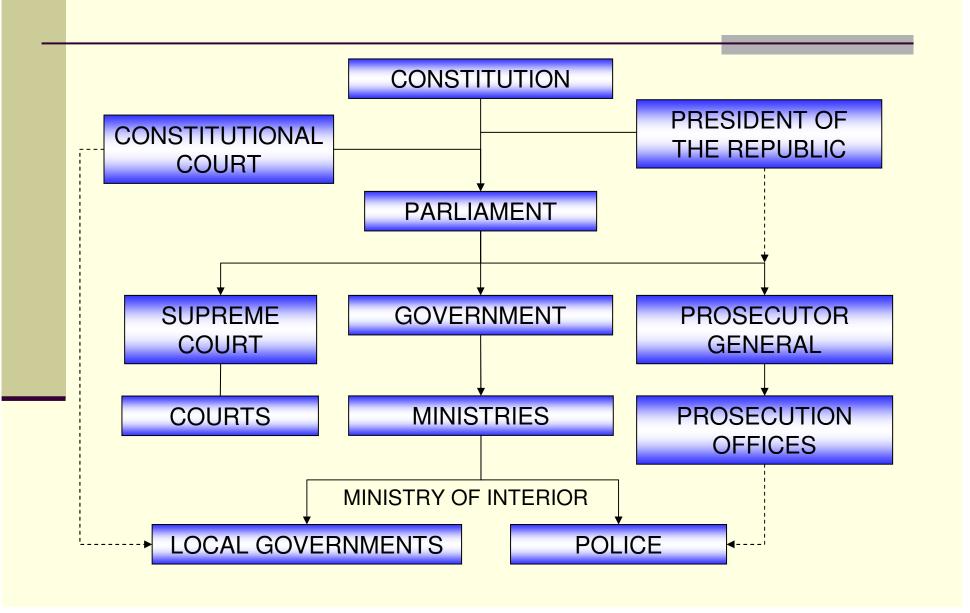

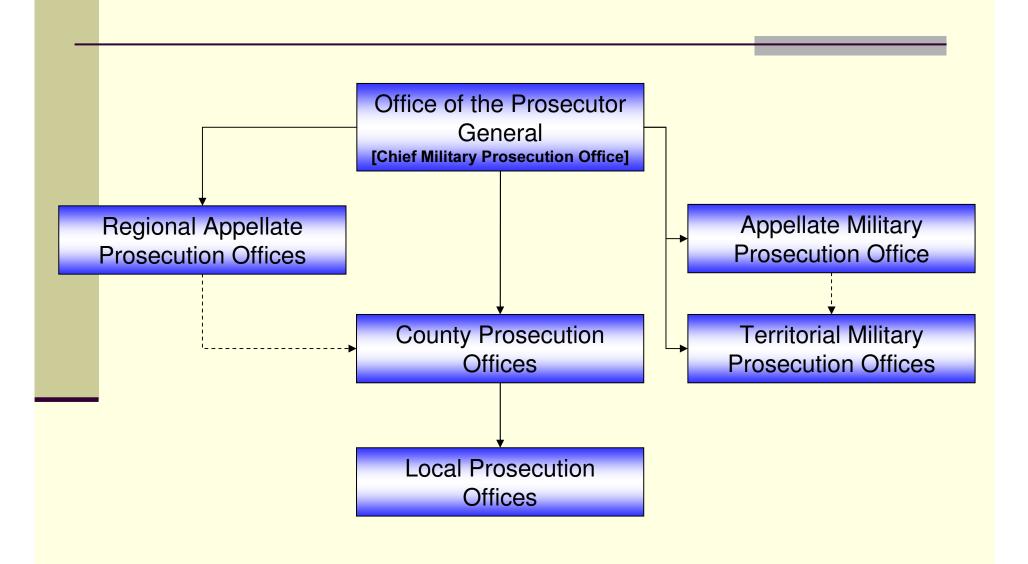

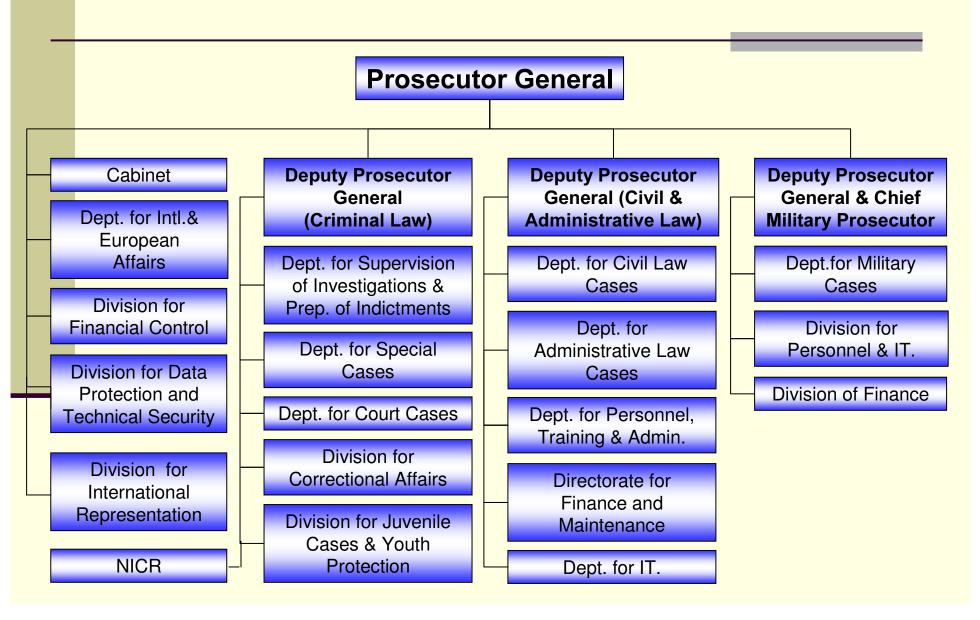
Constitutional structure of the Republic of Hungary



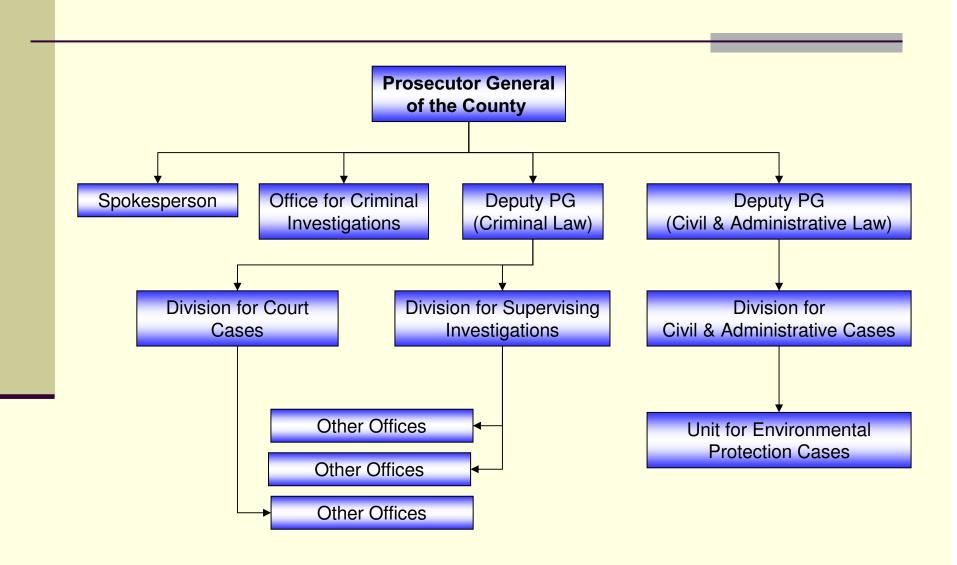
Organization of the Public Prosecution

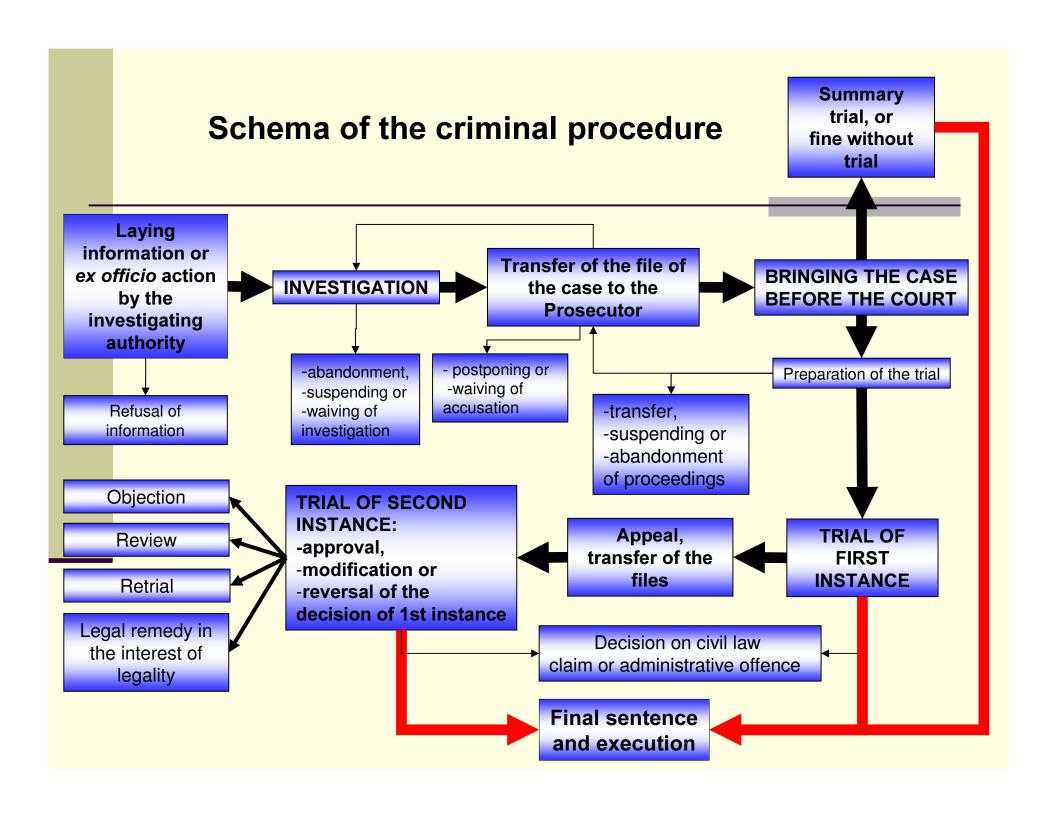


Organization of the Office of the Prosecutor General of the Republic of Hungary

The Prosecutor's functions in the criminal procedure

INVESTIGATION

- investigation
- legality supervision
- extention of deadlines
- decisions on complaints
- coercive measures

EXECUTION OF PUNISHMENT

- legality supervision
- decisions on complaints

BRINGING THE CASE BEFORE THE COURT

COURT PROCEEDINGS

- acting before the court
- proposal for coercive measures
- appeal
- extraordinary remedies

Activites of the Prosecution Service in the private and administrative law field

Constitution Article 51(3)

"The Prosecution Service shall help to ensure that everybody comply with the law. When the law is violated, the Prosecution Service shall act to uphold the law in the cases and manner specified by law."

Activities of the Prosecution Service in the private law field

In cases stipulated by law the Prosecution Service may contribute to the correct application of the law in court procedures _____

Contentious court procedures

(The prosecutor has competencies in certain civil law, labour law, economic law and administrative law cases)

- The status of the prosecutor in the case: plaintiff, coplaintiff or defendant
- The prosecutor may bring an action exclusively or in addition to others entitled by law
- The prosecutor may bring an action e.g. in the following fields of law: consumer protection, environment protection, nature protection, investor protection, family law, unlawful activities of civil organisations
- The prosecutor may bring an action for ceasing the injury incurred in the public interest by void contacts

Registry court and other noncontentious procedures

- The prosecutor may initiate noncontentious court procedures in cases stipulated by law (e.g. when a company fails to operate in compliance with legal regulations or with the provisions of its instrument of constitution)
- The prosecutor has the right to appeal against court decisions in registry cases of foundations and civil organisations

Activities of the Prosecution Service in the administrative law field

(supervision of legality)

Competences

The Prosecution Service exercises legality supervision over the

- laws,
- general instructions,
- decisions in individual cases issued by administrative organs inferior to the government

Means

The Prosecution Service has the following means for supervising the lawful operation of the public administration:

- giving opinion about certain draft legislation,
- regular monitoring of the legality of the legislation in force issued by the supervised organs,
- requesting data and information from the leaders of the supervised organs,
- holding or initiating inquires,
- examining petitions and complaints received by the Prosecution Service

Possible steps

When it is necessary in the interest of legality, the Prosecution Service may take the following steps:

- issuing protest, objection or warning (special legal instruments of the Act on the Prosecution Service),
- initiating criminal, disciplinary or contravention procedure, or action for damages,
- initiating the issuance, amendment or abrogation of legislation,
- issuing signals,
- others stipulated by law
