Setting the scene: work of CDBIO

 CDBIO entrusted by the Committee of Ministers to work on human rights in mental healthcare



- Basis: Relevant case-law of the European Court of Human Rights CPT reports - as well as Convention on Human Rights and Biomedicine and CM/Rec(2004)10
- Taking into account standards developed and work achieved by United Nations
 - Essential for CoE to take action to improving the protection and the autonomy of persons in mental healthcare services.
- Combination of complementary measures expressing CoE political will

Overall objectives

 Ensuring effective exercise of the rights of the person concerned



Promoting autonomy in mental healthcare



Incremental and consistent approach

Legally binding instrument focused on involuntary placement and involuntary treatment




- Most critical human rights issues Setting the general rule based on voluntariness, reducing, preventing involuntary measures and ensuring effective exercise of rights
- Report on the relevant case law of the European Court of Human Rights
- Compendium of good practices to promote voluntary measures in mental healthcare services
- New draft Recommendation on the respect of autonomy in mental healthcare
