Activity 2: Sharing intercultural encounters

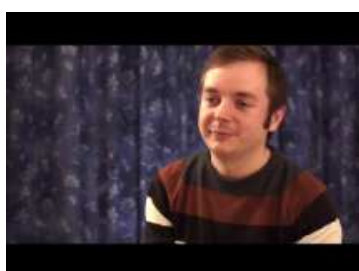
Interviewee profiles
