

Name of Action:

Restoration of the Former Men's Gymnasium building and establishment of the People's (Public) School (training centre)





Summary: It is planned to restore the former men's gymnasium building and establish a Folklore School (training centre for locals).

The centre will include the following sections: 1) meetings (conference halls with different facilities); 2) civil sector studies (training rooms, facilities) for various ages (including youth and the third age); 3) performance and cinema centre; 4) information centre; 5) recreation zone; 6) production (creative studio, shops, café); 7) children education centre and creative zone for small children.

Challenge(s) that the Action addresses:

Many of members of LSG noted the importance of establishing such a training centre, in which every member of the community would be able to access educational services. At the same time, it could be a place for various meetings of local community, as well as a children's cultural and educational centre.

There is no similar institution in the city at present, but such a centre is necessary as a rallying point for the community, to mobilize the local activity and increase personal and professional capacity. The centre will be partially self-sufficient and receive funding from educational and cultural services.
