ACTION PLAN 2017

The Group of Copenhagen Action Plan 2017 identifies aims and objectives / priorities for short term:

- A. Assistance to countries for the creation of new National Platforms:
- B. Support for existing National Platforms to consolidate and further improve their systems;
- C. support for members in the detection and management of the manipulation of risks relating to national and international major sports events taking place within their jurisdictions

The Group of Copenhagen Action Plan 2017 is focusing on the delivery of the following results:

- 1. <u>Leaflet</u> explaining the role of the GoC and functions. The leaflet is addressed to public authorities. The aim is to clarify how countries may use the GoC, and their benefits in joining it after the setting up of their national platforms.
- 2. <u>National Platforms factsheets</u> presenting detailed information about the existing National Platforms.
- 3. <u>Annual report of activity</u> presenting main activities and achievements of the national platforms and the Group of Copenhagen during the past 12 months.
- 4. <u>Harmonised tools for internal exchange of information</u> related to major sports events developed on the basis of good practices proposed by National Platforms.
- 5. Reference document(s) on national platforms developing all main topics related to the national platforms in order to contribute to the setting up of new national platforms.
- 6. <u>Database</u> should organise the pooling of all relevant information concerning the existing national platforms, the situation in countries regarding the implementation of the Macolin Convention's objectives (this should integrate the information already collected through the KCOOS project), and sports competitions manipulations.
