While this submission was forwarded to us as including observations on the admissibility of the complaint, it appears to include observations on the merits. While we welcome indications in the submission that further relevant law reform is imminent, this does not alter the substance of the complaint.

The complaint refers to a violation of article 7.10 of the Charter, which Cyprus has accepted.
