## **Practical Information**

### 1. Location

The Conference will take place in the **Agora building** of the Council of Europe, located on the corner of *Avenue de l'Europe* and *Quai Jacquot* (just across the street from the European Court of Human Rights).





#### 2. Arrival

<u>Please bring your passport/identity card</u> – or else you will not be able to enter the building.

Due to lengthy, individual security checks and registration upon arrival, you are advised to arrive 35-45 minutes before the Conference starts. You need to pick up a badge at the entrance of the Agora (the middle door) and then go through security clearance.

After you enter the building's main hall, the meeting room is downstairs on "level zero", Conference Hall G03. There you will need to sign in to enter the hall.

#### 4. Transportation


Below is some practical advice on transportation within Strasbourg and a further map showing where the Agora-building is located. Depending on your location, there are different options of getting there, such as:

BUS nr. 6 and nr. 30 will take you directly to the Agora building, stopping right in front of it.

**TRAM E** stops at **Droits de l'Homme** within a minute's walking distance from the **Agora-building**. See tram map below.

**TAXI** from downtown to the Council of Europe costs between 10-15 euros. Your hotel can of course easily order a taxi for you...

**WALKING!** In good weather, Strasbourg is a wonderful city to walk around in. Check the distance from your accommodation and perhaps you will feel like breathing in the spring air with a good walk to the Agora...
