#### **BIODIVERSITY INTEREST**

- PRESENCE OF MANY SPECIES AND NATURAL HABITATS OF EUROPEAN INTEREST
- MOST OF THEM LISTED ON APPENDICES OF THE BERN CONVENTION (several IBAs)
- AN OUTSTANDING UNIVERSAL VALUE UNDER CRITERIA (IX) and (X) OF THE WH CONVENTION
- EXAMPLE OF AN AREA WHERE THE NATURAL PROCESSES ARE STILL GOING ON
- DHA HAS BEEN SELECTED AS A POTENTIAL EMERALD SITE

#### SINCE THE LAST RENEWAL ...

- THE OVERALL STATE OF CONSERVATION OF THE DHA HAS IMPROVED SINCE 2013 (POSITIVE TRENDS)
- NEW SPECIES DISCOVERED (including flora, vertebrates and insects)





- HUNTING (ALLOWED ONLY IN A PART OF THE DHA)
- TURISM (NEED FOR A SUSTAINABLE TURISM STRATEGY)
- AGRICULTURE (LOCAL THREATS ON WETLANDS)
- INVASIVE (RESTORATION PROGRAMME)
- ROAD INFRASTRUCTURES (OUTSIDE THE DHA)

# IMPLEMENTATION OF THE (2) CONDITIONS AND (11) RECOMMENDATIONS ATTACHED TO THE 2013 RENEWAL

- THE 2 CONDITIONS HAVE BEEN FULLY IMPLEMENTED
- 5 RECOMMENDATIONS HAVE BEEN FULLY IMPLEMENTED
- ALL 6 OTHERS HAVE BEEN AT LEAST PARTLY IMPLEMENTED AND SHOULD BE ADAPTED AND PURSUED IN THE FUTURE

- THE EUROPEAN INTEREST STILL THERE
- THE MANAGEMENT MAY BE CONSIDERED AS SATISFACTORY BUT SHOULD BE IMPROVED IN SOME AREAS
- RECOMMENDATION TO RENEW THE ED FOR TEN YEARS WITH 1 CONDITION AND 6 RECOMMENDATIONS

 1 CONDITION: THE STATE PARTY SHOULD BE INVITED TO START THE PROCESS OF RENEWING AND UPDATING THE MANAGEMENT PLAN

#### 6 RECOMMANDATIONS: AND

- EXPAND THE STRICT PROTECTED ZONE OF THE DHA TO THE HISTORICAL LIMITS OF THE FOREST AND MANAGE THIS ZONE IN A NATURAL WAY (natural processes)
- IMPROVE THE MONITORING PROGRAMME (bio and socioeco database)
- SUSTAIN ITS EFFORTS AND PROVIDE THE DHA APPROPRIATE CAPACITIES (funding)
- BUILD UP A CLEAR AND SUSTAINABLE TURISM STRATEGY AND ENGAGE A MORE ACTIVE SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT POLICY WITH LOCAL STAKEHOLDERS
- FORBIDE WOLF HUNTING BY LAW AND DEVELOP A LONG TERM VISION FOR THE EUROPEAN BISON IN COOPERATION WITH POLAND (Bialowieza)
- DEVELOP A SPECIFIC CULTURAL HERITAGE
   PRESERVATION/MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME
