HELP Project on Radicalisation Prevention

- **Goal:** Improve criminal justice response **in the EU** to prevent radicalisation leading to terrorism/violent extremism
- **Specific objective:** Increase capacities & mutual trust of justice practitioners dealing with radicalisation prevention trough
 - Training
 - Inter-agency and cross-border cooperation

Duration: 2 years starting in Nov 2017

Budget: €620.000 (80% EU)

Stakeholders: Relevant CoE departments involved (prison, probation, counter-terrorism, interested partners (i.e. RAN, EU National Training Institutions, EJTN)



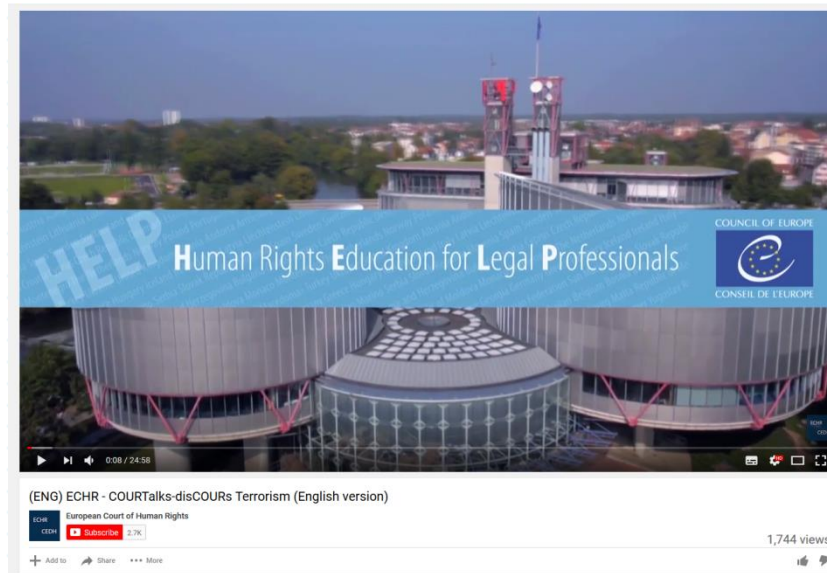

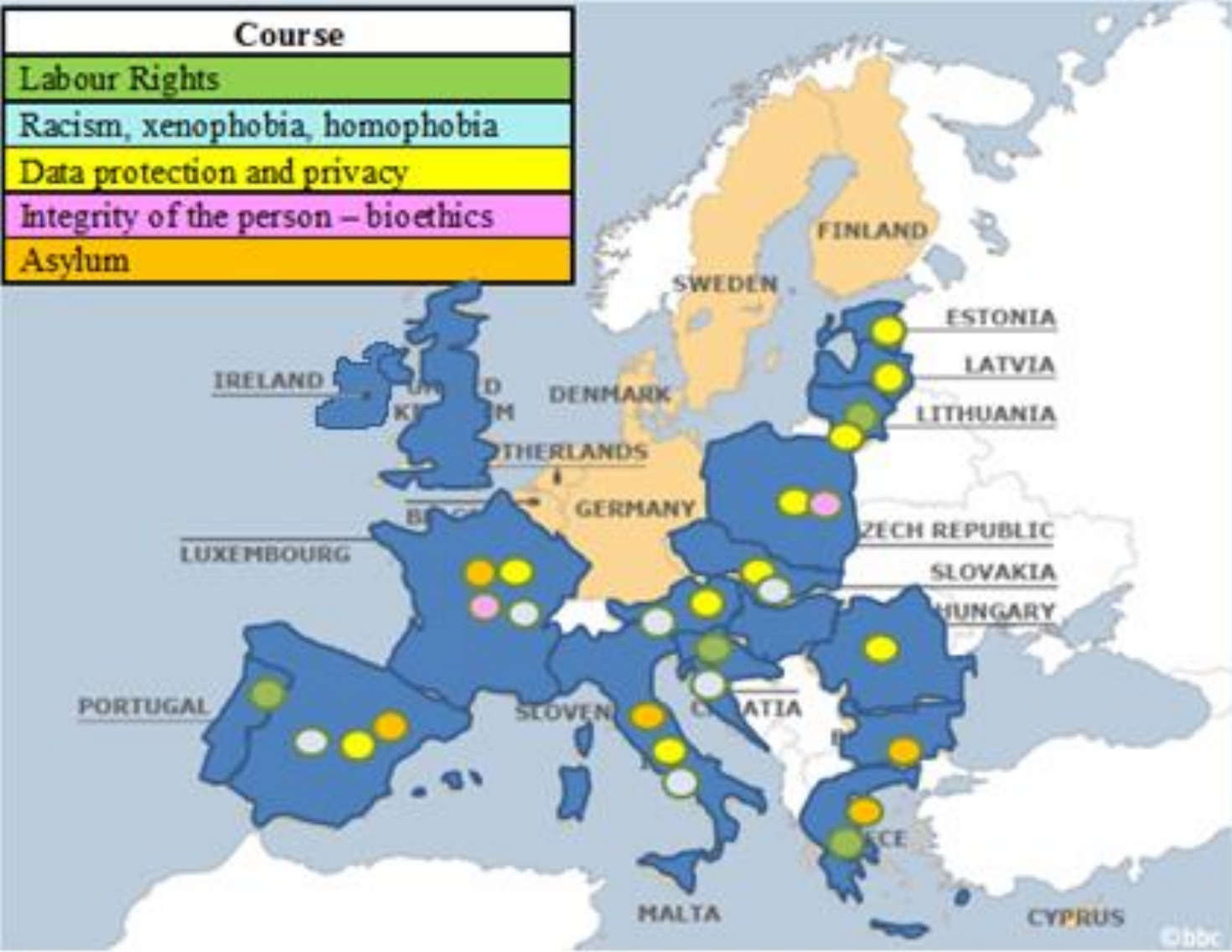
