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

Organisation of the Programme 2018-19




Budget split 2018-19



5 Joint EU-CoE Projects

“Democratic and Inclusive School Culture in Operation (DISCO)” open to **all 50 States party** to the European Cultural Convention (790 000 €) – 2 years as from January 2018

“Fostering a Democratic School Culture and Diversity ”: **Albania, Montenegro, Serbia and Kosovo*** (four projects) (1 900 000 €) - from June 2016 to December 2019

“Generation Democracy: Strengthening Culture of Democracy in Basic Education Institutions in **Turkey**” (2 750 000 € Joint EU-CoE Programme) - 3 years

“Fostering a Democratic and Inclusive Culture through Education and Youth Policy and Practice in **Romania**” (2 050 000 € EEA/Norway Grants) - 4 years

“Supporting a culture of democracy in and through education in the **Republic of Moldova**” (450 000 € Voluntary Contribution) - 3 years

Providing strategic advice to social inclusion programmes including large education components in **Bulgaria, Romania** and the **Slovak Republic** in its next cycle starting in 2018. (EEA-Norway Grants)

2 Projects

“European Qualifications Passport for Refugees”

Armenia, Canada, Germany, Greece, France, Ireland, Italy, the Netherlands, Norway, Slovenia and the United Kingdom, UNHCR

(100 000 € from the Ordinary Budget + 520 000 € voluntary contributions under negotiation) – 3 years as from January 2018

“Quality Education in Multi-Ethnic Societies - Ethnic Segregation in School in **Bosnia and Herzegovina**” -

(270 000 € Joint EU-CoE Programme) – 17 months as from January 2018


