



Support **legal professionals** to apply **European human rights standards (CoE + EU)** in their daily work, mainly by training





HELP Project on Radicalisation Prevention

- ➤ Goal: Improve criminal justice response in the EU to prevent radicalisation leading to terrorisms/violent extremism
- > Specific objective: Increase capacities & mutual trust of justice practitioners dealing with radicalisation prevention
- Development of a HELP course on RP and 4 national adaptations
 - Basic module(s) (for all)
 - Specific modules for
 - ✓ Prisons & probation staff
 - √ prosecutors &judges (prison oversight ones)
- Module gathering & use of evidence in counter-terrorism cases*







HELP in the Russian Federation: Summary for 2015-June 2018

- ➤ 4 ToTs and 2 HELP Trainers Conference
- ➤ 24 HELP distance-learning courses carried out by HELP trainers
- ➤ 1229 participants (lawyers, law lecturers, law students, civil servants)
- ➤ 121 lawyers visited the HQ in Strasbourg
- > 2 Courses developed in RF specifically for judges:
 - Admissibility of evidence in criminal proceeding
 - Reasonable time in criminal proceedings
