200+ prison staff learnt about the concept of dynamic security in prisons Dynamic security is when prison staff develop and maintain good relationships with prisoners and engage in meaningful and constructive dialogues with them





200 medical and non-medical staff of prisons learnt about medical ethics, mental healthcare, recording injuries indicative of ill-treatment, transmissible diseases and suicide prevention

Administrative Instructions developed:

1) staff recruitment,
2) disciplinary procedures and measures for inmates, and
3) complaint and appellate mechanism for prisoners
