Duration	27 months (1 October 2017 – 31 December 2019)
Partners and beneficiaries	<p>Partners: National training institutions and/or bar associations from targeted countries.</p> <p>Beneficiaries: Legal professionals (judges, lawyers, prosecutors) and other professionals working with refugee and migrant children. The latter are the ultimate beneficiaries.</p>
Main objectives	<p>General objective: Enhancing the protection of refugee and migrant children, mainly thanks to:</p> <p>(i) better equipped legal professionals assisting them but also</p> <p>(ii) empowerment by access to child-friendly legal support, information and procedures.</p> <p>Specific objective: To enhance legal professionals' capacities from targeted countries to effectively and coherently apply European human rights standards at the national level related to the protection of migrant and refugee children.</p>
Expected outputs and results	<p>Training modules on the rights of refugee and migrant children, on the European Social Charter and migrant children, on age assessment and guardianship, on family reunification and on alternatives to detention are developed, translated and adapted to national legal orders and freely available in the HELP online Platform</p> <p>At least 100 legal professionals, from four Council of Europe countries, trained in courses moderated by HELP certified trainers.</p>

Trainings of legal professionals in the beneficiary countries.
