## **TENDER FILE / TERMS OF REFERENCE**(Competitive bidding procedure / One-off contract)

# Purchase of <u>"Trainer for Webinars under the Sectoral Special Training Programme 2021 for Inspection Oversight in the Area of Education"</u> Contract N° 4708/2021/61



The Council of Europe (CoE)is currently implementing a joint European Union (EU)/CoE Programme "Human Resources Management in local self-government" - phase 2 (2018 -2021) (the "Programme" hereinafter). In that context, it is looking for a Provider for the provision of Trainers for Webinars under the Sectoral Special Training Programme 2021 for Inspection Oversight in the Area of Education (See Section A of the Act of Engagement).

#### A. TENDER RULES

This tender procedure is a competitive bidding procedure. In accordance with Rule 1395 of the Secretary General of the Council of Europe on the procurement procedures of the Council of Europe¹, the Organisation shall invite to tender at least three potential providers for any purchase between €2,000 (or €5,000 for intellectual services) and €55,000 tax exclusive.

This specific tender procedure aims at concluding a **one-off contract** for the provision of deliverables described in the Act of Engagement (See attached). A tender is considered valid for 120 calendar days as from the closing date for submission. The selection of tenderers will be made in the light of the criteria indicated below. All tenderers will be informed in writing of the outcome of the procedure.

The tenderer must be either a natural person, a legal person or consortia of legal and/or natural persons.

Tenders shall be submitted by email only (with attachments) to the email address indicated in the table below, with the following reference in subject: "Tender - Webinars for Education Inspectors 2021". Tenders addressed to another email address will be rejected.

#### B. EXPECTED DELIVERABLES

The expected deliverables are described in **Section A of the Act of Engagement** (See attached).

#### C. FFFS

All tenderers are invited to fill in the **table of fees** as reproduced in **Section A of the Act of Engagement**.

Tenderers subject to VAT shall also send a quote (Pro Forma invoice) on their letterhead including:

- the Service Provider's name and address;
- its VAT number;
- the full list of services;
- the fee per type of deliverables (in the currency indicated on the Act of Engagement, tax exclusive);
- the total amount per type of deliverables (in the currency indicated on the Act of Engagement, tax exclusive);
- the total amount (in the currency indicated on the Act of Engagement), tax exclusive, the applicable VAT rate, the amount of VAT and the amount VAT inclusive.

#### D. ASSESSMENT

Exclusion criteria and absence of conflict of interests

(by signing the Act of Engagement, <sup>2</sup> you declare on your honour not being in any of the below situations) Tenderers shall be excluded from participating in the tender procedure if they:

- have been sentenced by final judgment on one or more of the following charges: participation in a criminal organisation, corruption, fraud, money laundering, terrorist financing, terrorist offences or offences linked to terrorist activities, child labour or trafficking in human beings;
- are in a situation of bankruptcy, liquidation, termination of activity, insolvency or arrangement with creditors or any like situation arising from a procedure of the same kind, or are subject to a procedure of the same kind;
- have received a judgment with res judicata force, finding an offence that affects their professional integrity or serious professional misconduct;
- do not comply with their obligations as regards payment of social security contributions, taxes and dues, according to the statutory provisions of their country of incorporation, establishment or residence;
- are an entity created to circumvent tax, social or other legal obligations (empty shell company), have ever created or are in the process of creation of such an entity;
- have been involved in mismanagement of the Council of Europe funds or public funds;
- are or appear to be in a situation of conflict of interest;
- are or if their owner(s) or executive officer(s), in the case of legal persons, are included in the lists
  of persons or entities subject to restrictive measures applied by the European Union (available at
  www.sanctionsmap.eu).

### <u>Selection/engagement of civil servants and other public administration employees is subject to approval on the part of the Delegation of the European Union to the Republic of Serbia.</u>

Eligibility criteria

- University degree in Social Science OR equivalent 10 years' relevant work experience;
- Minimum 5 years professional experience in working with/working for education inspectorates at national or local level;
- Have been accredited as trainers by the National Academy for Public Administration (NAPA)/are currently on the NAPA list of accredited trainers in the appropriate area;
- Proficiency in Serbian and English languages.

#### Award criteria

- Quality of the offer (90%), including:
- Experience in analysing, drafting and/or implementing strategic and legal documents related to education inspection oversight;
- Experience in working directly with inspectors at central and/or local government levels;

<sup>-</sup> An extract from the record of convictions or failing that an equivalent document issued by the competent judicial or administrative authority of the country of incorporation, indicating that the first three and six th above listed exclusion criteria are met;

<sup>-</sup> A certificate issued by the competent authority of the country of incorporation indicating that the fourth criterion is met;

<sup>-</sup> For legal persons, an extract from the companies register or other official document proving ownership and control of the Tenderer;

<sup>-</sup> For natural persons (including owners and executive officers of legal persons), a scanned copy of a valid photographic proof of identity (e.g. passport).

- Experience in conducting analysis of primary and delegated responsibilities of local selfgovernments (experience in analysing/assessing/understanding the relationship between duties of central and local education inspectorates);
- Specific knowledge of legislative framework related to general inspection oversight and the work
  of education inspectorates (for example: the Law on Inspection Oversight; familiarity with other
  related umbrella laws is desirable: the Law on General Administrative Procedure and the Law on
  Administrative Disputes; Law on Education Inspectorate, Law on Elementary Education and
  Upbringing, Law on the Fundamentals of the Education System, as well as related by-laws);
- · Experience in conducting trainings;
- Knowledge of administrative appeals procedures/decisions/best practices is desirable in the areas covered by the accredited SSTP for education inspectors for 2021.
- Financial offer (10%).

The Council reserves the right to hold interviews with eligible tenderers.

Multiple tendering is not authorised.

#### E. NEGOTIATIONS

The Council reserves the right to hold negotiations with the bidders in accordance with Article 20 of Rule 1395.

#### F. DOCUMENTS TO BE PROVIDED

Tenderers are invited to submit:

- A completed and signed copy of the Act of Engagement<sup>3</sup> (See attached)
- For tenderers subject to VAT <u>only</u>: a quote, describing their financial offer, in line with the requirements of section C of the Tender File (see above);
- A list of all owners and executive officers, for legal persons only;
- CV (no longer than 4 pages);
- Motivation letter addressing award criteria (no longer than 2 pages);
- Proof of accreditation issued by NAPA.

All documents shall be submitted in English or Serbian, failure to do so will result in the exclusion of the tender.

If any of the documents listed above are missing, the Council of Europe reserves the right to reject the tender.

The Council reserves the right to reject a tender if the scanned documents <u>are of such a quality that the documents cannot be read once printed.</u>
