On Thursday, April 23, 2015, during the 2nd Part of the 2015 Ordinary session of the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe, Ms Elena Rapti participated in the 22nd meeting of the PACE Network of Contact Parliamentarians to stop sexual violence against children jointly with the Committee on Culture, Science, Education and Media on the theme of "Sex and relationship education as a means of preventing sexual violence against children".

Ms Elena Rapti spoke on the progress of the "ONE in FIVE" campaign in Greece and had the opportunity to present two new tools of the Greek campaign. Specifically, she presented "Nicky's Secret", a cartoon history (3D animation video) in Greek characters conveying all the messages of the campaign to parents, teachers and especially to children, in an educational and entertaining manner, thereby contributing substantially to public awareness and ultimately to the protection of children. She has also presented the new version of the fairy tale "Kiss and the hand" specially designed in tactile form for blind children or children with vision impairments with text and verbal description of the images in code - writing Braille and embossed illustrations in order to be legible through touch. This new version was created on the initiative of the Deputy Rector of the University of Macedonia, Professor Konstantinos Papadopoulos in collaboration with Elena Rapti.

I am quite satisfied by the fact that the Ministry of Health in cooperation with the NGO "The Smile of Child" will shortly create in Athens a "Day Center for children and adolescents who have been victims of abuse/neglect/domestic violence".

November 18th European Day on the Protection of Children against Sexual Exploitation and Sexual Abuse

On 12 May 2015, the Committee of Ministers of the Council of Europe took a decision to establish a European Day on the Protection of Children against Sexual Exploitation and Sexual Abuse, following the proposal made by the PACE in its Recommendation 2045 (2014) on combating sexual violence against children: towards a successful conclusion of the ONE in FIVE Campaign.

The European Day will be marked on 18 November in member states of the Council of Europe through awareness-raising activities with the strong involvement of civil society.

What is the purpose of the new European Day?

Sexual exploitation and sexual abuse of children are still a tragic reality for all our societies. They are a serious violation of children's rights, and have long lasting and often detrimental consequences for their entire life.

To prevent these crimes, prosecute the perpetrators and protect the victims, the Council of Europe and its member states need to make sure that parents, educators, NGOs and decision-makers do not shy away from the problem, but bring it to light and discuss ways and take practical steps to solve it.

The objectives of the European Day are therefore to:

- raise public awareness of sexual exploitation and sexual abuse of children, and the need to prevent such acts;
- facilitate open discussion on the protection of children against sexual exploitation and sexual abuse and help prevent and eliminate the stigmatisation of victims;
- promote the ratification and implementation of the Lanzarote Convention – a unique legally-binding instrument that obliges European states to criminalise all forms of sexual abuse of children and spells out the ways to fight it.

The European Day will add on to the work of the Council of Europe and its member states under the ONE in FIVE Campaign to stop sexual violence against children, which will end in November 2015. The European Day activities will help maintain the momentum it created.

It will also offer an occasion to explain what the Council of Europe does to protect the rights of the child, in line with the European Convention on Human Rights, the European Social Charter and the Council of Europe Strategy for the Rights of the Child.

Who is the European Day for?

This day is meant for children and for everyone who interacts with children in their personal or professional capacity:

- parents;
- local, regional and national authorities;
- professionals working with children, including educators, sport coaches, law enforcement agents, etc;
- non-governmental organisations;
- the private sector.

* As decided by the Committee of Ministers of the Council of Europe 12 May 2015.

How will the European Day be marked?

The European Day is to be organised in a flexible and decentralised manner.

Council of Europe member states will take ownership for marking the European Day. They will hold national actions and decide themselves on the initiatives they wish to take, particularly through the use of social media, already existing networks, and actively involving civil society. Possible actions include lectures at schools; discussions; flash mobs; road-shows; screening of films on the topic of sexual violence against children; creative initiatives and media events.

The Council of Europe will set up in 2016 a dedicated web page containing:

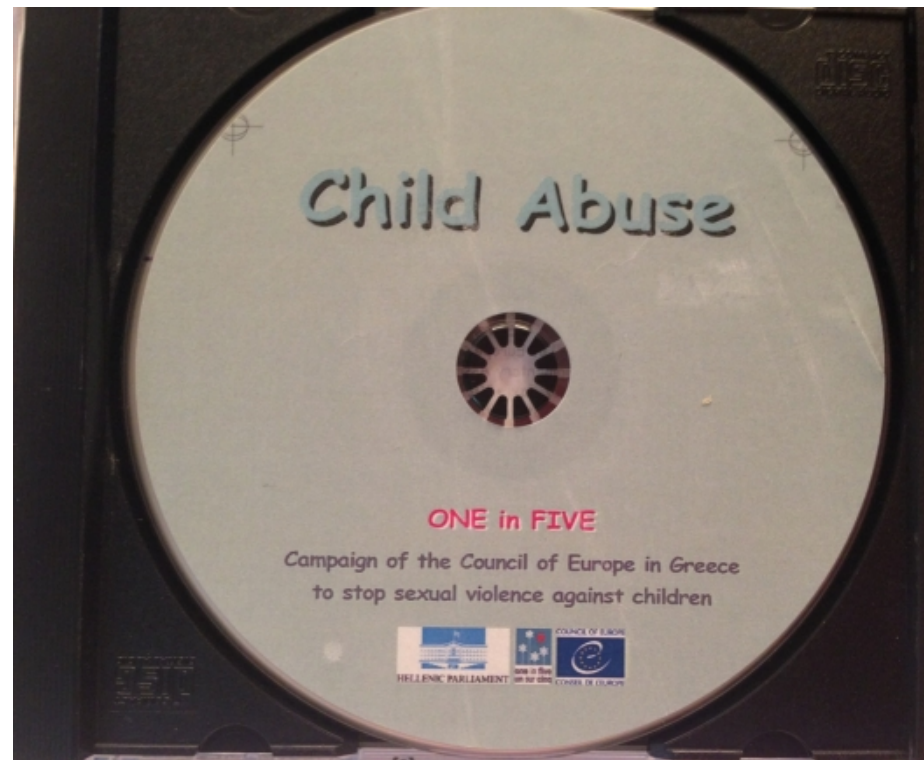
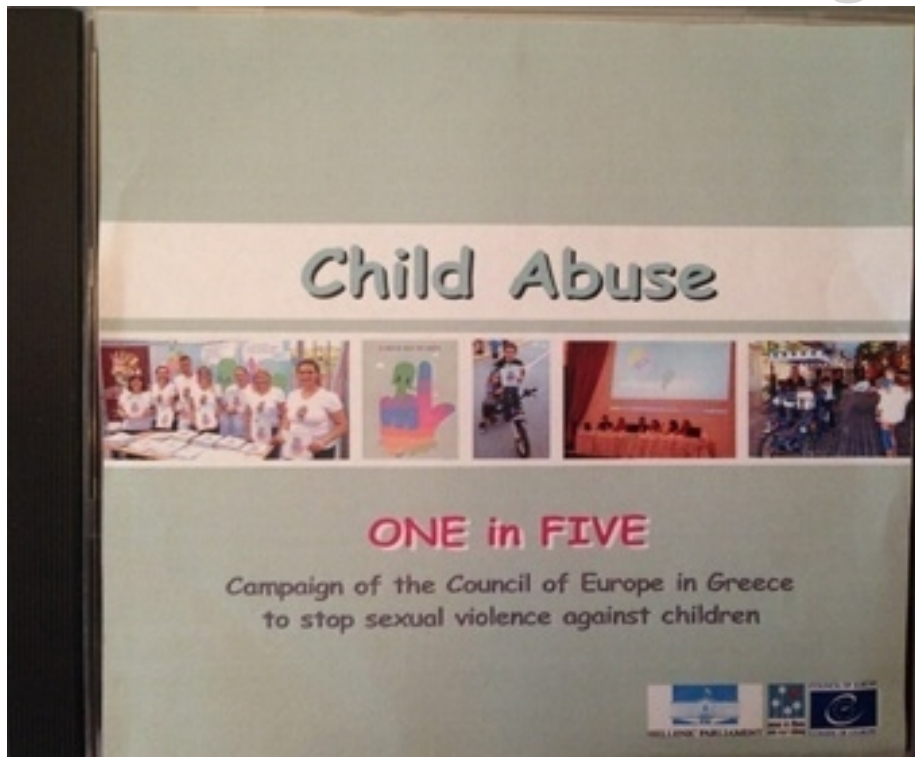
