- carried out independently by each state being a member of the network

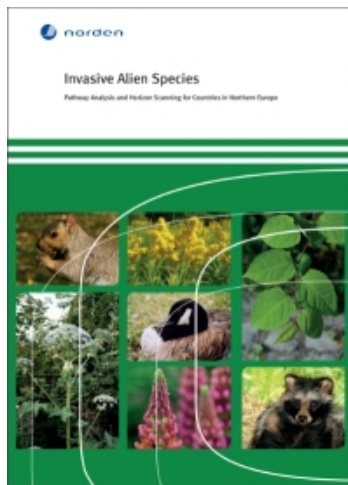
NOBANIS today:
