Sharing the vision: local democracy and ethical governance in practice

Purcari Winery, Purcari, Republic of Moldova 27-28 September 2017

Objective

This meeting is organised to share the experiences and good practices of the local initiatives on ethical governance and transparency implemented by the municipalities of Budesti (Chisinau), Costesti (Ialoveni district) and Palanca (Stefan Voda district) with other Moldovan mayors, in particular those from the district of Stefan Voda.

Envisaged as a peer review, this meeting also aims to discuss sustainability of these local policies, in the framework of local self-government and territorial reforms.

Context

Three municipalities from Moldova – Budesti, Costesti and Palanca are implementing local initiatives on ethics and transparency. Expert guidance, along with financial support, was provided to each municipality. Tailored to the specific objectives of each local initiative this support aimed to increase the quality and to ensure sustainability and higher impact of these new policies.

This support scheme is a follow-up to a series of national workshops and regional seminars organised over the previous two years, providing the opportunity for mayors from the Eastern Partnership region to exchange views on their day-to-day challenges, as well as their roles and responsibilities as leaders of change. They shared best practices, with a focus on the need to plan effectively and strategically, involving relevant stakeholders and fostering the participation of citizens in local decision-making.

The meeting "Sharing the vision: good practices on local democracy and ethical governance" is organised within the thematic programme "Strengthening institutional frameworks for local governance", as part of the CoE/EU Partnership for Good Governance (PGG) 2015-2017 for Armenia, Azerbaijan, Georgia, Moldova, Ukraine and Belarus. The programme is implemented by the Congress of Local and Regional Authorities of the Council of Europe (the Congress), in close co-operation with the Directorate General for Democracy.
