## Strategy 2017

#### Vision

Leopards and all wildlife prosper in natural habitats across the Caucasus ecoregion in harmony with people

#### Goal

Ensure the conservation and sustainable management of viable meta-populations of leopard and wild prey and their habitats, and build sustainable coexistence mechanisms with local communities across the caucasus ecoregion



## Strategy 2017

#### Objectives

- 1. Increase viability of leopard and prey populations
- 2. Establish joint standardised monitoring & research (incl. central database)
- 3. Promote foundation of new leopard populations through reintroduction
- 4. Establish effective networks of protected areas and corridors
- 5. Improve leopard and prey protection outside protected areas
- 6. Ensure long term support from local communities
- 7. Improve awareness, education and training for target groups
- 8. Strengthen international, transboundary cooperation
- 9. Optimise existing policies and if necessary develop new policies

10. Improve efforts to secure international funding for conservation activities
