
THE RESEARCH METHODOLOGY:











National Quality Label and Quality Criteria for Youth Centres

- add opportunities to involve young people in the process of establishing quality criteria.














EXPERIENCE OF PARTICIPATION OF YC/YS EMPLOYEES IN THE STATE PROGRAMME "YOUTH WORKER"



The participants of the research also named the following trainings:


- "Creating a safe environment for children and youth in conditions of war",


