GETTING TO TORINO



BY AIR

TORINO AIRPORT

The airport is about 16 km from the city centre, about half an hour's drive, and boasts a good transport service to the town centre, both by bus and train, as well as taxi of course. The airport has daily flights to major Italian and European cities.

MILANO MALPENSA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

This airport is located at about 100 km from Torino and offers daily international and intercontinental flights.

BY TRAIN

Torino is very well linked both to the Italian railway system and to that of neighbouring countries. High-speed trains are used nationally and internationally, Frecciarossa and Italo for Italy and TGV for France, and allow to reach Paris for example in about 5 hours. The new high-speed lines also allow to reach Milan in only 44 minutes and Rome in 4h 05'.

HOW TO REACH THE CITY CENTRE

FROM TORINO AIRPORT

BY BUS

The centre of Torino is easily reachable in 45 minutes using the SADEM bus service (www.sadem.it).

One-way fare: € 6.50 (+0.50 € aboard).

The public taxi rank is located on the left at the exit of the Arrivals level.

Travel time: approximately 30 minutes.

HOW TO GET TO CURIA MAXIMA-SALA BOBBIO - Via Corte d'Appello 16

BY TRAIN

- from **Porta Nuova** Railway Station:
bus 52 (dir. Borgo Vittoria), bus 11 (dir. Venaria - Corso De Gasperi), tramway 4 (dir. Falchera) get off after 4 stops (at Garibaldi) and walk for about 300m. Estimated time 15 minutes

- from **Porta Susa** Railway Station
Star 2 bus (dir. Cairoli), get off after 4 stops (at Orfane) and walk for about 100m, estimated time 15 minutes; bus 51 (dir. Mezzaluna), get off after 3 stops (at Garibaldi) and walk for about 300m, estimated time 15 minutes

BY PLANE

Torino Airport is 16km away from the city. The public is located on the left at the exit of the Arrivals level.



The conference room is housed inside the "Palazzo dei Supremi Magistrati" or "Curia Maxima".

During the Savoy reign it hosted the Royal Senate and the Board of Auditors.

The palace was designed and built by Filippo Juvarra in the 1700 at the behest of the Savoy Duke Vittorio Amedeo II.

In the following years the building underwent other works by the architect Benedetto Alfieri and later finished by Ignazio Michela in 1838.

Porta Palazzo, a world tour around a square

- *Departure:* via Corte d'Appello 16 (venue)
- *Starting time:* 15.30 (walking to Porta Palazzo, 500meters)

Short description of the tour:

15.30-17.30 – At Porta Palazzo, the largest outdoor market in Europe, distances disappear. You will see nineteenth-century Galleria Umberto I, learn about the historic shops and the Art Nouveau pavilion of the Ancient Clock Roof, continue to Asia, Africa and Latin America for the shops surrounding the square. The intercultural walk ends at 17.30 at CasArcobaleno (Rainbow House) in via Lanino 3.
