Data collection on hate crimes has improved through stronger collaboration between public institutions and civil society organisations.

42 police database operators received training to ensure **more accurate and efficient data collection on hate crimes.**





Police officers now have better access to training resources on equality and non-discrimination. An updated trainers' kit was developed with the General Police Inspectorate, and the Manual for Police Education on Equality and Non-discrimination is now available in Romanian.





About 300 legal professionals from national judicial institutions are now better prepared to handle hate speech and hate crime cases, in line with European anti-discrimination standards.







Support for parents, civil society activists, experts, and representatives of anti-discrimination institutions working with LGBTI children and teens has improved through awareness-raising initiatives and events, including the 2024 International Felis Conference.
