Co-production Support

The results of the third Eurimages Project Evaluation Session of 2025 have just been announced. Further to recommendations made by independent experts meeting online, the Executive Committee of the Fund has decided to support **the co-production of 33 feature films, including 10 documentaries and 5 animations**, for a total amount of €9 696 000.

Of the 33 co-production projects supported during the session, 12 are to be directed or co-directed by women. This represents 29.38% of the total funding awarded.
