RESOLUTION (81) 36

ON THE REMUNERATION OF SPECIALLY APPOINTED OFFICIALS

*(Adopted by the Committee of Ministers on 7 December 1981
at the 341st meeting of the Ministers' Deputies)*

The Committee of Ministers, under the terms of Article 16 of the Statute of the Council of Europe,

Having regard to Resolution (71) 8 on the remuneration of specially appointed officials of the Council of Europe, as last amended by Resolution (81) 2 ;

Having regard to the decision reached at the 341st meeting of the Ministers' Deputies approving the 187th report of the Co-ordinating Committee of Government Budget Experts on the new salary scales for A and L grade members of the permanent staff with effect from 1 July 1981 ;

Whereas, as a result of that decision, and in accordance with Article 2 of Resolution (71) 8 referred to above, new basic salary scales for the specially appointed officials of the Council of Europe need to be established,

Resolves as follows :

Single article — The basic annual salaries laid down in Article 1, paragraph *a*, of Resolution (71) 8, as last amended by Resolution (81) 2, shall be adjusted as follows with effect from 1 July 1981 :

- Secretary General 389 330 FF
- Deputy Secretary General and Clerk of the Assembly
having the rank of Deputy Secretary General 368 473 FF
